QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be a proficient skater and have sound knowledge of ice skating skills. Experience planning and teaching structured skating lessons; preparing evaluation sheets and writing progress cards; and setting up equipment needed for lessons. Provide exceptional customer service to participants and have the ability to work effectively in a team environment. Have a genuine interest in teaching hockey skills to children and adults; an enthusiastic, energetic and positive attitude; and excellent communication skills.

REQUIRED LICENSES, CERTIFICATES AND REGISTRATIONS:

Candidates must have current Emergency First Aid, High Five Certification, Skate Instructor course (within 3 months of employment, available through NVRC). Teaching/Instructing experience and NCCP accreditation are considered an asset.

All Commission employees should be prepared to work at any Commission location. All candidates are required to submit a Police Record Check as a requirement of the position prior to any appointment. Clearance requires the absence of any criminal charges or convictions related to this position.
