# I. Call to Order

# a) 2020 Committee Appointments

Chair Porter reviewed the committee appointments. Director Turner asked the Commissioners to forward their interest in being appointed to a committee to Chair Porter and herself via email within a week's time. The appointments will be finalized prior to the next Commission Meeting.

# b) North Vancouver Recreation & Culture's Role in Health and Wellness

Director Turner spoke to the extended scope of the report since it was an opportunity to share additional information on the Commission's role in health and wellness beyond initiatives with the health authority.

A discussion was held on presenting this information to both Councils. Councillors Muri and Curren suggested presenting this information at a District Council Meeting under their committee reports. Councillors Back and Girard suggested drafting an Information Report for City Council. Additionally, Councillor Girard suggested that Director Turner reach out to the RCMP Superintendent due to his interest in health and wellness, and Councillor Back suggested that Heather meet with him to discuss the Commission's role.
