I. Call to Order

Chair Green called the meeting to order at 7:19 pm.

II. Approval of the Agenda

Moved by Commissioner Woodworth; **seconded** by Commissioner Rzen

IV. Director's Report

Director Turner reviewed the report and answered questions from the Commissioners.

V. Items for Discussion/Decision

a) Arts & Culture Grants Recommendations: Second Intake, 2016

Commissioner Rzen introduced the Arts & Culture Grants Review Committee Chair, Betsy Agar. Betsy spoke to the report and the adjudication process. She encouraged the Commissioners to read through the project descriptions attached to the report and to attend the events.

Commissioner Leia suggested that the dates of the funded events be provided along with the report and Director Turner answered that in future they can be included.

Moved by Commissioner Clark; seconded by Commissioner Rzen

- (1) **THAT** Arts & Culture grants totaling \$207,250 be awarded to support the operations, programming, projects or events of twenty-two organizations as recommended by the Arts & Culture Grants Review Committee;
- (2) **THAT** a Community Public Arts Assistance grant in the amount of \$3,200 be awarded to Westview Elementary School PAC as recommended by the Arts & Culture Grants Review Committee;
- (3) **AND THAT** \$22,500 in grants be awarded to support three civic events as outlined in this report.

THAT the existing agreement between the North Vancouver Recreation & Culture Commission and the North Shore Neighbourhood House for the provision of recreation services on the east side of Lower Lonsdale be extended to December 30, 2016.
