

Thank you for your interest in volunteering with North Vancouver Recreation and Culture Commission (NVRC). This letter will provide you with all the information you need to make your participation as effortless as possible.

Volunteer criteria:

- Minimum age of 14 years
- Volunteer Application Form
- Police Information Check
- Two references
- Photo Release Form
- Volunteer Agreement
- Interview
- Training

Step 1: Complete and submit the online application form.

Step 2: You are required to provide a minimum of two references and have the option of:

☐ having **two** references complete the form found on the website on your behalf. The form is a fillable form and your reference can send it directly to volunteer@nvrc.ca with "reference for (your name) in the subject line).

☐ providing your references' contact information for us to contact on your behalf (which in our experience often takes longer)

☐ or use a reference letter(s) that you have already

Step 3: Read and sign your volunteer agreement and confidentiality form and if you are under 18 years of age, have your parent or guardian sign it.

Step 4: Submit the police information check to the RCMP. The North Vancouver RCMP is located at 147 E 14th street North Vancouver between Lonsdale and St. Georges avenues.


- You must present a letter from us requesting the police information check to be conducted (this letter can be found in the volunteer forms area).
- There is no cost to you if you are volunteering
- You must apply for your police information check in the jurisdiction in which you reside. If you live in North Vancouver, you may apply in North Vancouver. If you reside in Burnaby, you must apply in Burnaby, etc.
- The RCMP requires at least 4 weeks advance notice to process applications. We cannot guarantee that you will be able to participate in your activity unless we receive the processed police information check back.
- The RCMP will require **two** pieces of identification to complete the CRC. If you do not bring them with you, you will not be able to apply. Acceptable ID: Go Card (student ID), Passport (in English only), Drivers License, Birth Certificate, Citizenship Card, Nexus Pass, Student or Work Visa (NOT a Visa Credit Card), BCID Card, Permanent Residence Card, Firearms Acquisition Certificate. **Note: Care Cards and Social Insurance Number Cards are not acceptable forms of ID.**

Step 5: Once your forms are completed, please submit your forms (all of them together if possible) to volunteer@nvrc.ca
