

## **NVRC Call for Artist Residencies**

North Vancouver Recreation and Culture's (NVRC) Artist Residency program provides unique opportunities for emerging and established artists from various disciplines, cultures and life experiences to create and produce new works of art or develop existing artistic projects.

The program provides staff and marketing support, financial support, and space in a Community Centre, field house or the Centennial Theatre. Residencies can be as short as six weeks and as long as six months with varying schedules. Those accepted to the program are expected to engage with the community in the development of their work through a short performance, workshop or an artist talk.
