# Pass Holder Firing Deadlines & Production Limits

## Production Limits

- 6 cubic feet per season/passholder - measure rim to rim, foot to foot.
- Objects must be under 12 inches in any direction (measured at greenware stage).
- 3 pieces per season can be between 12-18 inches in any direction.
  - These objects are included in your total 6 cubic feet for the season.
- Plates, platters & ornaments: make a reasonable amount as these are hard to load into a kiln and take up a large amount of space.

## Firing Deadlines

- These are in place to make sure people can complete all their work by the end of the season.
- No single firing of pottery allowed.
- These deadlines must be followed. There will be no exceptions.

**Reminder:** No greenware or bisqueware will be allowed back into the studio next season: everything must be completed by the end of this season.

Date	Deadline
<b>June 23</b>	No new work
<b>June 25</b>	Greenware must be bone dry and on shelf for firing
<b>July 4</b>	All bisqueware must be glazed on shelf for firing.
<b>July 4</b>	All personal supplies must be removed from the studio. All shelves removed & cleaning
<b>July 25-Aug 3, 2026</b> Mondays 5-8pm, Tuesdays 12:30-3pm, Thursdays 12:30-2:30pm, Saturdays 10am-1pm	Pottery pick up.  You may only come during the times listed. No personalized accommodations will be made.
