Safety and Field Use Management

If there is no soccer game scheduled immediatly following your game, it is the home team's responsibility to ensure the goals are put away and locked up in the designated location.

There have been reported injuries from children playing on goals not in use.

Teams that do not return & lock-up goals may be subject to a \$150 service charge

Field Use Guidelines for North Vancouver 8vs8 Soccer Teams

The first step before you setup the field for play is:

Check that your grass field is open for play. Check online under playing fields at www.nvrc.ca. The web site is updated regularly through the soccer playing season. Coaches can also try our twitter account for information regarding field playability at @DNVfields.

To prevent field damage, you may not play on a field that is waterlogged, soft/muddy, frosty, or has standing water.



FIELD GUIDELINES

- Set up the field as per attached field diagrams.
- ✓ Avoid goalmouth and use alternate sidelines each week, i.e. use north sideline one week, south sideline the next to prevent field damage.
- ✓ Pace out the field, using one pace per meter, mark it with a cone.
- Mark the field perimeter, the penalty area, the 20-yard "offside" lines and the center line.
- All goal and field sizes may need to be adjusted slightly to avoid damaging soft field locations.
- First team that plays the first game of the day sets up the cones and the nets. The last team that plays the last game of the day picks up all the cones and puts the nets away and locks them up.

To unlock Super 8 goals use lime shack key. Purchase this key \$5 from Delbrook Rec Centre front desk.


Reminders

All spectators must stand on the outside of the full size 11vs11 soccer field to prevent wear & tear on the playing surface.


No dogs permitted on the field and sidelines.


