Community Conversations on Anti-Asian Racism English Session

Since the start of the Covid-19 pandemic we have been witnessing a rise in racism, and anti-Asian racism in particular, on the North Shore and beyond. We would like to invite those who have been impacted by anti-Asian racism to come together to share their feelings and stories in a supportive environment. This is also an opportunity for community members of Asian descent to make recommendations on how we can work together to prevent anti-Asian racism and better support victims of hate on the North Shore.

This event is for anyone who identifies as Asian, including from East Asia, South Asia, Southeast Asia, Central Asia and Western Asia. In using the broad geographic meaning of "Asian" we hope to build connection and support across Asian immigrant communities on the North Shore (including Chinese, Iranian, Filipino, Korean and many others), while recognizing unique ethno-cultural identities, histories and legacies of racial violence.

In order to be accessible to more people in this community we will hold one session in English, one in Mandarin, and one in Farsi. This listing is for the English language event.
