



## 2021 Inclusion Worker Program Application

North Vancouver Recreation and Culture is happy to offer the Summer Inclusion Worker Program!

Before submitting an application, please review the following:

- Applications are processed on a first come first served basis. Inclusion spots will be offered to applicants in order of when their application is received until all spots are filled or until the application closing date.
- To support Covid-19 safety guidelines, Inclusion Workers are designated to specific camp locations for the duration of the summer. When an application is approved you will be provided with information regarding available locations and dates.
- The Inclusion Worker Program is a good fit for those who work well in the equivalent of a 1:3 ratio and who could participate independently at times under the general camp supervision.
- Inclusion Workers are camp leaders who may have some experience supporting children who have disabilities or other support considerations and are in place to support the entire camp team. They are not hired as 1:1 workers, interventionists or specialized support caregivers.
- A maximum of 1 consecutive week of camp support can be provided.
- Campers are encouraged to attend additional weeks of camp with a private support worker.
- We are not able to schedule training, orientations or introductions outside of the assigned week of support. If your child requires specialized behaviour or medical support, or other support that would require training or an orientation, please contact the Inclusion Programmer prior to applying to discuss eligibility (604.983.6415).
- In the unlikely event that an Inclusion Worker is unable to make a scheduled shift, NVRC staff will do their best to find a replacement. If a replacement is not found then a modified schedule for the day or cancellation altogether may be necessary.

### Application Steps / Timeline

1. Applications will be accepted starting **May 3rd at 9:00am** via email [summersupport@nvrc.ca](mailto:summersupport@nvrc.ca) or in person at Harry Jerome Community Recreation Centre, and will be accepted until May 18th at 3pm. Applications submitted after May 18th may not be considered.
2. As part of the application process, you will be contacted via phone to discuss the application, to provide additional information, and to assess eligibility for the program.
3. If approved, camp locations and available dates will be discussed and confirmed
4. Between May 20<sup>th</sup> and June 1<sup>st</sup> you will be contacted to complete camp registration for the pre-determined week of camp. You will not be required to register your camper on camp registration day for the assigned week of NVRC support. If registration has not been completed by June 1<sup>st</sup> then the inclusion spot cannot be held.
