- Parent Participation Open Gym at Lynn Valley Community Recreation Centre (6months-4years old) on Tuesdays from 10-11:30am and Thursdays from 10:45am-12:15pm for \$2.50 per child or \$4 per family (cash only)
- Family Drop-In Climbing at Parkgate Community Centre one night only on Saturday November 29 6-8pm for only \$2 per person.
